# MASTERPIECE Grantchester

**POPULAR SERIES' FINAL SEASON**

We've spent years in Grantchester, where a vicar and a cop solve crimes—and quietly carry each other through whatever life throws their way. Now, it's time for one final season with this thoughtful, familiar duo.

In the momentous summer of 1963, Alphy reconnects with his estranged mother and questions his faith. Geordie faces a promotion that could end his crime-solving partnership with Alphy, and Cathy's career soars. As Leonard discovers his paternal side and Miss Scott faces a life-changing event, the Grantchester family must face love, loss, and forgiveness one last time.

In the season premiere, Alphy's drive-in fundraiser turns deadly when a sponsor is found murdered, and multiple suspects confess. As Alphy faces painful truths about his mother and faith, Geordie grows jaded, Cathy clashes with Mrs. C, and Leonard searches for purpose.





## **THE LAST TWINS** *Unsung Hero of the Holocaust*

**15 Monday at 9:00PM**

This new documentary presents the story of Erno “Zvi” Spiegel, an unsung hero of the Holocaust who risked everything to protect some of the most vulnerable in Auschwitz—dozens of young boys, many of them twins, targeted by Dr. Josef Mengele for brutal pseudo medical experimentation. Through courage, compassion, and ingenuity, Spiegel shielded these young children from death and unimaginable harm. When liberation came, he didn’t stop—he led the boys across war-torn Europe on a harrowing journey towards their homes. **The Last Twins** is narrated by Tony Award-winning actor Liev Schreiber, and was executive produced by Spiegel’s daughter, Dr. Judith Richter.

Through first-hand testimony and exclusive archival material, **The Last Twins** brings to life the voices of the boys who survived because of Spiegel’s defiance. His acts of humanity didn’t just save lives—they created a legacy. Today, the children he protected have families of their own, with descendants who are researchers, advocates, lawyers, and musicians, living all over the world.

“Erno Spiegel’s story reminds us that even in the darkest places, there are people who choose to act with courage and compassion,” said co-director Perri Peltz. “**The Last Twins** is a tribute to one man’s quiet defiance and the children whose lives and legacies he helped preserve.”

Follow the story of two women whose lives are irrevocably changed by their husbands' diagnoses with Lewy body dementia (LBD), a widespread, but little-known condition. After struggling to find information about her husband Jim's disease, Linda Szygula starts a podcast about LBD with Curry Wisenhunt, a Texan truck driver who also has the disease. Their efforts grow into a unique online support community for those living with the disease as well as their caregivers. In this support group, Linda meets Carla Preyer, who has just quit her job to care for her husband, Patrick. They bond over their shared challenges and the dark humor they use to cope. Their friendship and their connection to the support group help them deal with their grief, rise to the demands of caregiving and emerge whole on the other side.
